



Florida Celtic Soccer Club Application for Financial Assistance 2021/2022

Florida Celtic Soccer Club is a 501(c)3 non-profit corporation dedicated to providing superior quality soccer opportunities to its youth membership. Florida Celtic Soccer Club charges an annual player fee to all players, to participate in team activities. The club has limited financial aid available to players who would otherwise be unable to play soccer with Florida Celtic Soccer Club.

In addition to our financial aid program, we also offer Scholarships to players who meet specific criteria determined by the donor. The generosity of our donors, most often a current or alumni player or family, is what makes these scholarships possible.

There is a 3 step process you **MUST** complete for Florida Celtic Soccer Club financial assistance:

1. **Complete your online registration** using the link provided to you by the Florida Celtic Soccer Club. This allows you to register and secure your spot on the team while your financial aid application is processed. This requires a non-refundable deposit and payment of volunteer fee.
2. **Complete the 1-page application** and submit with the required documentation (tax return)
3. **Email your application and requested documents** to info@celticfl.net OR mail to:

 - o Once you have completed all 3 steps, You will receive email notification *within 5* business days. You will have 24 hours to respond.

NOTES:

- 1) Timing of your application is **EXTREMELY** important, as our financial assistance dollars are limited.
- 2) All information submitted is **STRICTLY CONFIDENTIAL** and is used for the **SOLE** purpose of determining award amount, and parent's ability to assist with funding. Failure to **REGISTER** with the link OR **SUBMISSION OF REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION** will delay and may limit amount of award due to availability.
- 3) All recipients of financial aid are required to complete volunteer hours for club events and or administrative duties. There are many opportunities to do so (e.g., field set up & break down at home games, staffing at tournaments, staffing at fundraising events, videotaping games, admin support ... or if you have an idea, business, or talent you can offer). Our staff will notify you of your required volunteer assignment well in advance of the event.
- 4) If your financial assistance award is being supported by a scholarship donor, you will be notified.
